Beawar is the largest producer of cement in northern India and home to Shree Cement. Beawar was founded by Colonel Charles George Dixon (1795-1857) in 1836. Beawar was part of British India, and the administrative headquarters of Merwara district. Beawar, the name of the city comes from the name "Be Aware" which was originally a sign given to the city by a British Emperor.
